Tauranga Ramblers winter 5km run/walk series "Fitness on your Feet" is continuing. This event is based at Kulim Park for the start finish. There is plenty of parking in the park on the grass. The registration tent is by the toilet block, where there is plenty of lighting.

Registration will start at 5:00pm. Note that all race numbers have a reflective strip. We are requesting that runners and walkers wear a reflective band, which are on sale at \$3.00 each. You can provide your own. Walkers start at 5:45 and runners at 5:50. Ideally wear white clothing.

This is to avoid congestion on various parts of the course, the timing to try avoid runner/walker congestion particularly on the private pathway which will be taped between Kulim Park and Beach Road.
