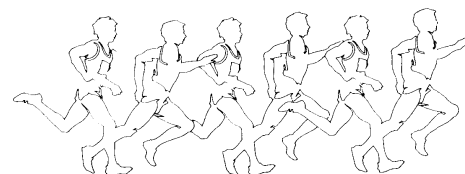

SYLVIA POTTS CLASSIC

Gareth Hyett showed plenty of strength and speed in winning the 1000m at the new Regional Sports Park.

Ben Ruthe provided the pace over the first 600m for the large top class field, leaving Hyett to lead into the final lap and the head wind on the back straight. Tim Hawkes, who beat Hyett over 800m in Tauranga on New Year's Day, did not have the same sting over the final 150m and Hyett forged his way down the final straight to record 2m 23.06s. Brett Tingay of Christchurch produced a strong finish for second in 2m 23.66s with Hawkes third in 2m 25.78s.
