SURVEY RESULTS: WINTER CLUB SEASON REVIEW 2009

Statistics can often be boring and open to wide interpretation and while survey participation was about 50% of active club members they were enthusiastic about club events and activities.

J 80% respondents are running both road and cross country

J club activities and said the events were important to them and even more important to the club, furthermore the involvement in regional and national events came in at 83%

Ø Interestingly, participants only attended half of the events on offer [54%] although injuries accounted for a third on non attendance. All was not lost though as two thirds stated they often attended meetings if not running which would indicate a good social climate within the club

Ø The level of satisfaction of non competitive events came in at 47%, now couple that with the fact that 83% of members enjoy a training run together would indicate that members enjoy
